Rationale and justification for the ITEC Programme at MANAGE, Hyderabad

The robust capabilities of the Indian agriculture extension system, nurtured by MANAGE along with other research organizations and State Agriculture Universities, highlight the need to share these experiences for the advantage of policymakers, administrators, researchers, and field-level officials in other countries.

In addition to disseminating India's experiences and expertise through the ITEC programs on the Promotion of Public-Private Partnership in Agriculture and Allied Sectors, we anticipate benefiting from collaborative efforts with other nations.
