Sufficiency Economy Philosophy builds community food security

2. Duration:

10 days (3-13 November 2025)

3. Background:

TICA: Thailand International Cooperation Agency

TICA is a national focal point for Thailand's international development cooperation. It was established in 2004 to realize Thailand's aspiration to be a contributor to international development cooperation. Believing that global challenges are best addressed through international cooperation and global partnership, TICA continues to work closely together with its development partners to realize the global development agenda through various capacity-building and human resources development programmes. In response to the recent changes in the global landscape of development cooperation, TICA has strengthened its partnerships to harness the synergy of South-South and Triangular Cooperation to tackle global development challenges, including expediting the implementation of Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). It also continues to realign our focuses to deliver Thailand's commitments to be a relevant partner in global agenda including the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development.

Since 1991, TICA, in collaboration with educational institutions in Thailand, has offered short-term training courses under its Annual International Training Course (AITC) programme. The number of courses offered each year varies between 25 to 35 courses for 20-35 participants per course. AITC not only fosters good and friendly relations which Thailand has already enjoyed with recipient countries across regions, but also helps Thailand to reach out to those countries with which we desire to engage more closely. CMRU' Best Practices Supporting Community Food Security Development

Education: at least at a bachelor's degree in any fields;
Language: proficiency in English (speaking, reading, and writing)

Evaluation

Actual locations in Chiang Mai Rajabhat University and various communities in Chiang Mai Province

1. The participants will learn the Sufficiency Economy Philosophy to support food security development in their own countries.
2. The participants can learn the practical and innovative assessment of food security.
3. The participants will have an opportunity to create their academic links with knowledgeable persons in sustainable community development.
4. TICA and the Faculty of Agricultural Technology, Chiang Mai Rajabhat University, can gain a reputation as organizations offering academic assistance to people interested in agricultural and food security development.

1. Course Title:

Training on fundamental quality and efficiency tests of disinfectants for livestock production

2. Duration:

16th – 27th June 2025

3. Background and Rational:

TICA: Thailand International Cooperation Agency

TICA is a department under the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Thailand and a national focal point for international development cooperation with development partners and other developing countries around the world. TICA was established in 2004 to realize Thailand's aspiration to be a contributor of development cooperation. TICA's mission is to promote sustainable socio-economic development through sharing of knowledge and best practices. In response to the recent changes in the global landscape of development cooperation, especially through the concept of South-South and Triangular Cooperation, TICA continues to realign our focuses in order to deliver Thailand's commitment to be a relevant partner in global agendas including the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development.

4. Objectives:

The program is designed to: veterinarians, animal husbandmen, and scientists who entail laboratory practice in quality control of livestock products, animal health, or related fields with four objectives

1. To train the test method for determination of active ingredients (quality) in disinfectant for livestock production by titration method and high-performance liquid chromatography technique.
2. To train the test method for efficiency test of disinfectants by Use-Dilution method according to the Association of Official Analytical Chemists (AOAC)
3. To promote the role of laboratory practice in the control of the quality of disinfectants for livestock production
4. To learn the regulation and control of disinfectants for livestock production in Thailand

5. Course contents:

1. Introduction to disinfectant, the regulation and control of disinfectants for livestock production in Thailand, the role of laboratory practice in the control of the quality of disinfectants for livestock production and the fundamental method for determination of active ingredients in various groups.

2. Technique of analysis for the determination of active ingredients in disinfectants for livestock production.

- Training on manual titration technique: redox titration (iodometry) for determination of iodine complexes as available iodine.
- Training on potentiometric titration technique for determination of iodine complexes as available iodine.
- Training on determination: determination of glutaraldehyde and formaldehyde by UHPLC-DAD technique.

3. Introduction the efficacy testing of disinfectant products using the use-dilution method according to AOAC standards, techniques for preparing culture media used in testing, techniques for preparing microorganisms used in testing, techniques for preparing sample in testing.

- Training on the efficacy testing of disinfectant products using the use-dilution method with ATCC 10708, *Salmonella enterica*, ATCC 6538 *Staphylococcus aureus*, ATCC 15442 *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*

6. Participants criteria:

Applicants must fulfill the following requirements:

- Be nominated by their respective government
- Veterinarians, animal husbandmen or scientists who entail laboratory practice in quality control of livestock products, animal health or related fields with four objectives.
- Language: Proficient in English

7. Attendance and evaluation:

Participants who completed the training will receive a certificate based on:

- Real time class attendance (not less than 80%)
- Interactive class participation
- Presentation and report
- Evaluation

4. Understanding the regulation and control of disinfectants for livestock production in Thailand

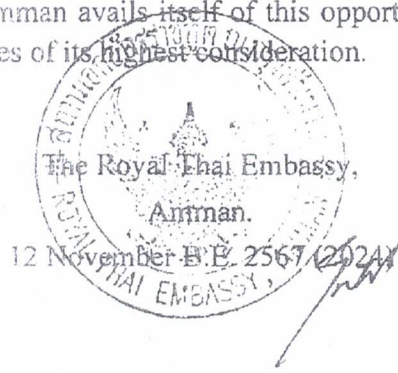
