In recent years, it has gamered increasing global attention. As the demand for animal disease prevention and control continues to grow worldwide and green medical practices gain traction, natural, safe, and effective veterinary technologies have become a key focus in international animal health. The Advanced Training Program on Traditional Chinese Veterinary Medicine is designed with three core objectives. Firstly, the program aims to systematically train experts, promote the international application of TCVM diagnostic and treatment techniques, and enhance the disease prevention and biosecurity capacities of participating countries. Secondly, by strengthening international collaboration in research, the

program seeks to align TCVM product standards with global requirements, accelerate technology transfer, and modernize the discipline. Lastly, through joint research, knowledge exchange, and platform-building, the program will support China's science and technology diplomacy strategy and contribute to innovation in global animal health governance.

Purpose: With the internationalization of Traditional Chinese Veterinary Medicine at its core, the Advanced Training Program on TCVM aims to systematically train global scientific and technical professionals, facilitate the dissemination of traditional TCVM theories and practices, and expand industry development opportunities. - (3) Hands-on training and exchange meetings On-site lectures and workshops: Hands-on practice in modern TCVM techniques. Visits to relevant enterprises modern agricultural demonstration zones, and on-site training aligning with the training themes and course content. Exchange seminars with agricultural management departments, farmers, and enterprises.
- (4) Tours Visits: Gansu Provincial Museum in Lanzhou, Central Street in Harbin, etc. to learn about Chinese culture.
