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Center of International Cooperation Service serves as the lead unit for foreign aid training programs within the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Affairs (MARA) system. The center has established a comprehensive management system for foreign-related training programs, emergency management, and financial regulations. With rich experience in implementing foreign aid training, a broad range of training fields, extensive country coverage, and a highly professional team, the center has achieved remarkable training outcomes. Since 2005, the Center has hosted 187 training sessions, with 4,662 management and technical personnel from 140 countries, regions, and international organizations. Funding sources come from the Ministry of Commerce, the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Affairs, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, the Ministry of Finance, and international organizations such as the World Food Programme (WFP), the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO), and the Center for Sustainable Agricultural Mechanization (CSAM). - 6.Overview of Shandong Province's Agricultural Product Processing and Trade: Presenting case studies on export tax rebate policies and cutting-edge institutional innovations within free trade zones, demonstrating the leverage effect of policy instruments on trade capacity enhancement.
- 7. Advanced Processing Technology for Agricultural Products: Showcasing state-of-the-art developments in China's agricultural product processing, providing in-depth analyses of processing technologies and methodologies, alongside strategic approaches to industrial chain extension through technological innovation and iterative improvement.

8. Current Status and Trend Analysis of International Agricultural Product Trade: Exploring machine learning models for forecasting potential tariff barrier reductions within

regional trade agreement frameworks (such as RCEP).

- 9. Exchange and Discussion: Organizing country-specific exchanges, thematic discussions, and cooperation meetings with representatives from China's agricultural authorities, research institutions, and related enterprises. The focus will be on exploring ways to enhance global food security and encouraging participants to actively propose solutions about agricultural products trade and market access tailored to their respective countries.
