	3. About the lecturers (1) Bao Minzhen: Ph.D., Associate Professor. His main research areas include the formation mechanisms and functional improvement of reconstituted materials. Since 2019, he has participated in international bamboo training courses organized by the Ministry of Commerce. He has presided over domestic scientific research projects such as the National Natural Science Foundation of China, Zhejiang Provincial Natural Science Foundation, and provincial-academy cooperation projects. He has published over ten SCI papers and serves as a reviewer for journals such as Forests, Construction and Building Materials, and European				

Journal of Wood and Wood Products.

(2) Prof. Wang Hong, DG of Institute of Forest Resources Information Technology, CAF. He is mainly engaged in plantation technology, comparative study of Chinese and Western forestry. Since 2011, he has been specialized in research of national reserve forest policy and technology, promoting the inclusion of timber reserve issues in central documents and industry planning, and participating in the drafting of the "National Reserve Forest System Plan". He has over 20 years of experience in fast-growing forest projects and international loan afforestation.

(3) Prof. Pang Yong, doctoral supervisor, chief scientist of Forest Resources Information Technology, CAF, leading scientist of National Forest and Grass Technology Innovation, and deputy head of the Remote Sensing Working Group of the International Forestry Federation. He has long been engaged in forestry remote sensing mechanism model, remote sensing data processing and its application in forestry, regional forest cover mapping and carbon storage

estimation etc.,

(4) Ding Xingcui: Professor and Ph.D. thesis advisor. His main research fields include bamboo forest cultivation and international cooperation, covering studies on bamboo growth and development, aging and flowering regulation, bamboo shoot flavor quality and environmental regulation, bamboo introduction, international bamboo industry development models, and cooperation. He has presided over and participated in more than 20 bamboo projects at home and abroad and has organized 150 training sessions, training over 6,000 participants.
