

## Introduction

Natural disasters such as floods, cyclones, droughts, and earthquakes tsunamis. impact human history, profoundly particularly in developing regions where vulnerability is heightened by limited resources and capacity. The adverse effects of such events are more severe in developing countries, where loss of life, livelihoods. droughts, floods, and epidemics. The impact of these disasters has been devastating, with substantial economic losses and long-term social consequences. Governments in disaster-prone regions have made concerted efforts to mitigate the effects of these disasters. Strategies include the development of institutional frameworks, technological forecasting tools and

models and, and the promotion of a culture of prevention preparedness and resilience. In Pakistan, for example, the government has implemented a comprehensive disaster management strategy, including the establishment of a National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) and a National Institute of Disaster Management (NIDM) to respond adequately and effectively to disasters.

Recognizing the importance of the subject, AARDO, in collaboration with the Regional Office of AARDO and AHKNCRD, Government of Pakistan is organising an International Training Workshop on "Disaster Management and Climate Change Adaptation" at AHKNCRD, Islamabad, Pakistan.

### **Aims and Objectives of the Workshop**

The broad objective of the workshop is to share experiences and build capacity of participants to address issues related to disaster management and climate change adaptation. Specific objectives of the workshop are to:
